
Once you are in the Event Lobby, click on YOUR VTI SCHEDULE to access the MY COURSES page.


LAUNCHING YOUR SESSIONS

On the MY COURSES page, you will see all the courses you are already registered for. The week of the event come back to this page to launch your courses by clicking the LAUNCH button.




STEP 5: ZOOM LINKS AND ADDING TO YOUR CALENDAR




REGISTER FOR ADDITIONAL FREE PEER LEARNING SESSIONS/UNREGISTER





Select which Exchange option (webinar, faculty-led courses or one-week workshop) you want to exchange.




